ENTRY: Regatta will be limited to 30 boats per class.
Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached entry form and submitting it 14 days prior to the regatta with an entry fee of \$20 for one day or \$40 for both Saturday and Sunday.
Breakfast, Lunch and drinks provided both days.
Awards for first 3 competitors in each class.

SCORING: The regatta will be scored with the Low Point Scoring system as set forth in Appendix A of the RRS. If there are more than 24 competitors for DF65 and more than 22 competitors for DF95 races will be run under the P/R Race management system.
One race to be dropped for every 6 sailed.
