On behalf of the Marathon Sailing Club, I would like to invite you to the beautiful Florida Keys to sail CR 914's in our first race of our 2014 Interclub Regatta on Sunday, March 2, 2014.

We will be sailing in the protected waters of an old quarry that we call Valhalla Quarry. It is located directly off US1 at Mile Marker 56.6 on the Bay side (**Going south – on your right side**). This is 4.4 miles south of Duck Key. There is plenty of parking (look for our the signs) but no toilet facilities. Mangroves are available however. There are gas stations further south as you get towards Marathon. This is salt water and you are welcome to wash off your boats at my house after racing.

The schedule is as follows: Saturday evening, March 1 @ 6:00 PM, I will hold a social at my house on Duck Key, 328 E. Seaview Drive, (410) 404-3093. We will serve dinner complete with wine, beer and soft drinks at no charge for you and your family, so just bring your appetite. Please RSVP so I know how much food and booze to have.

On Sunday morning, we will be launching at 9-10 AM at Valhalla Quarry and race until about 1:00 PM, in an effort to get all visiting sailors on the road at a reasonable hour. A light breakfast and a lunch will be included for

you and your family. Prizes will be presented for the top 3 finishers. There will be a nominal \$15 / boat registration fee collected on Sunday morning.

Sailors are welcome to come back to my house and tell outrageous stories and even extend your vacation in the Keys and stay overnight if you like.

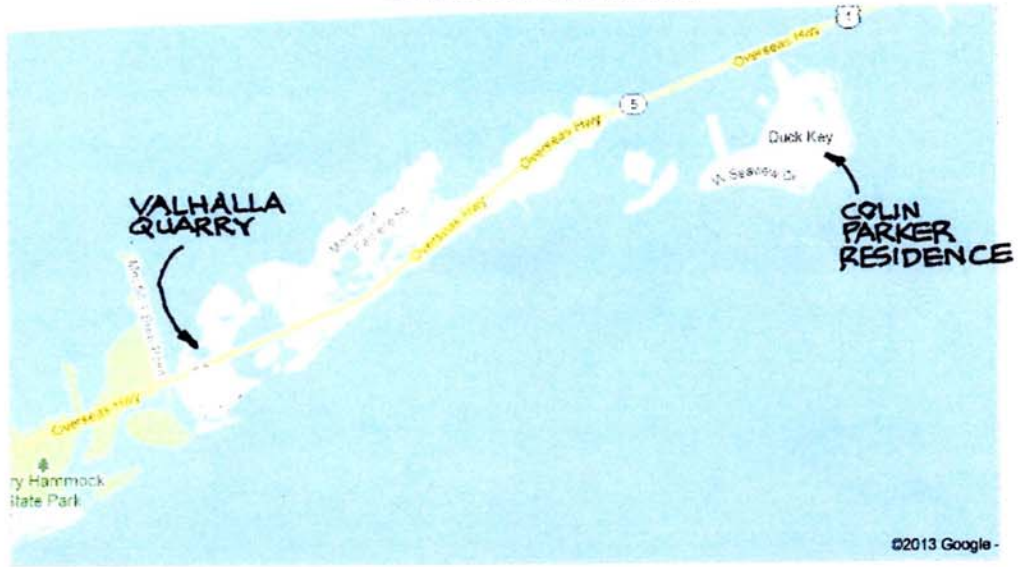
Welcome to the Florida Keys! We hope to make this a rewarding experience and encourage participation and try to make this an annual event.

Thanks and may we have fair winds and good sailing.

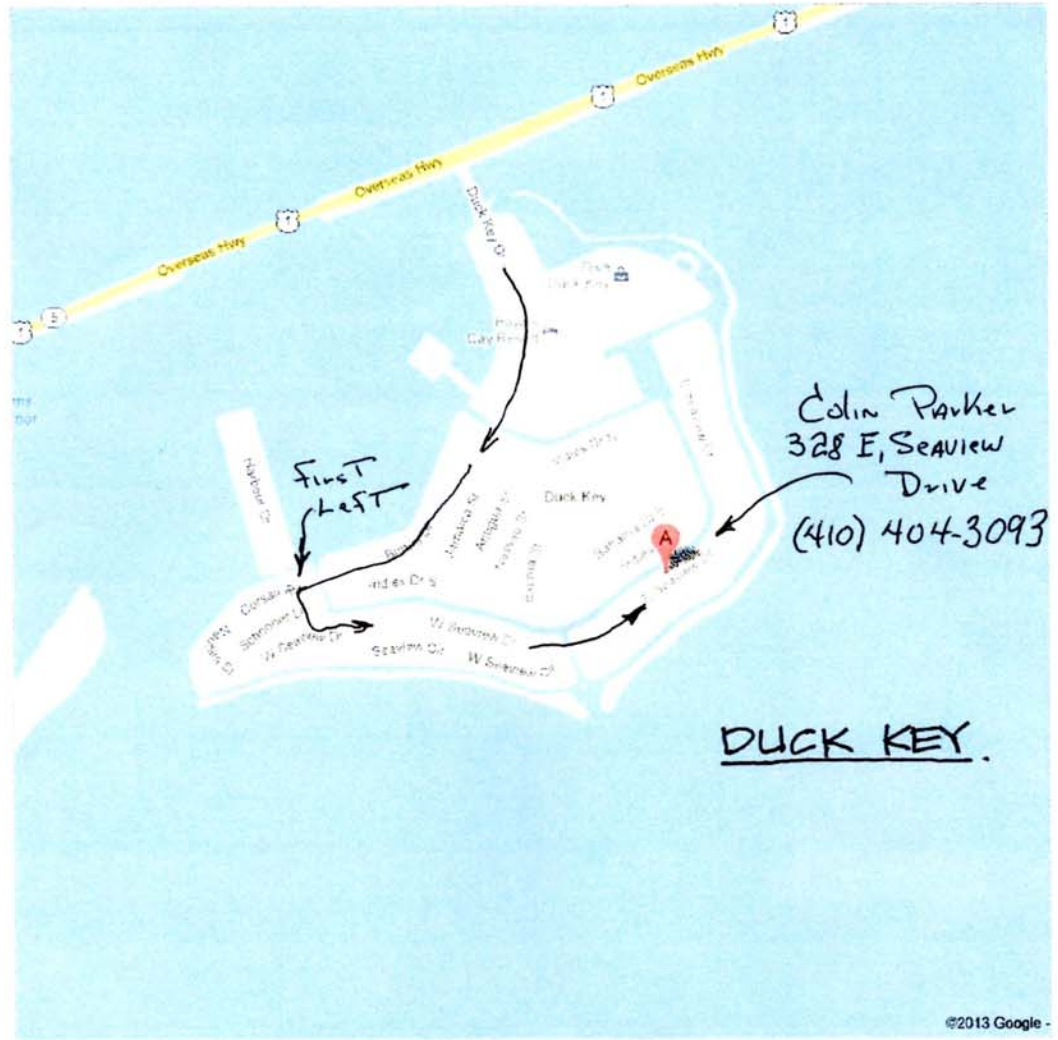

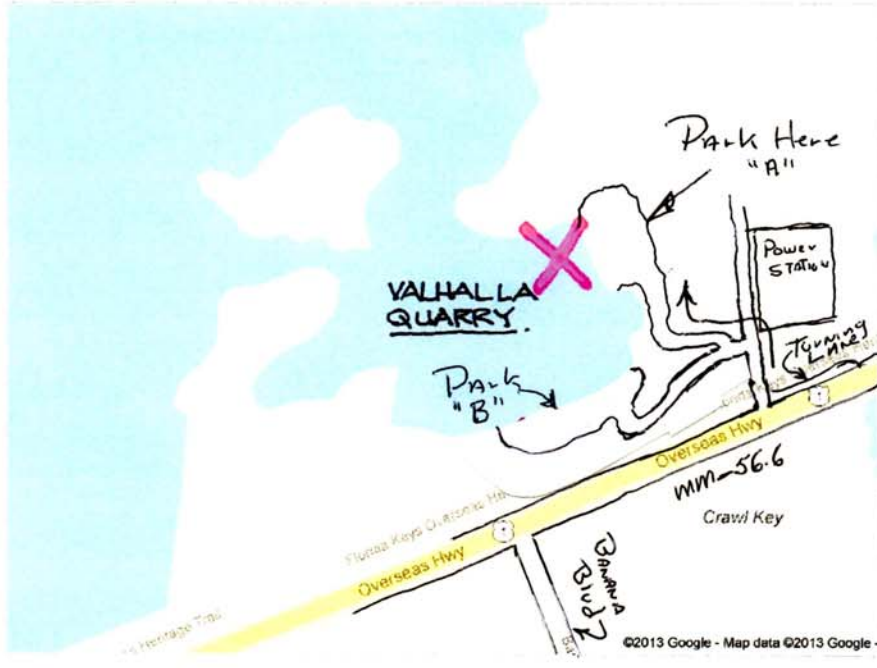
Stage I-Marathon Florida
